

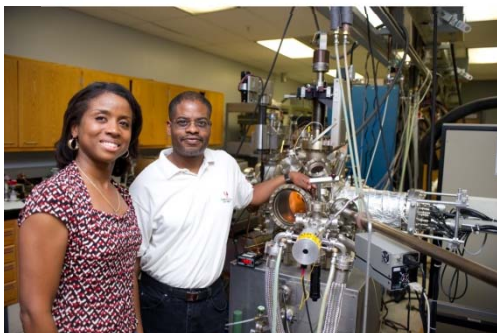

Physics majors are invited to apply to participate in a ten-week undergraduate research program that is hosted by Georgia Tech, Spelman College, Clark Atlanta University and Morehouse College.

Participants will gain broad perspectives by participating in a dynamic research environment while working with a faculty member at one of the four partner institutions. Projects span the field of physics, ranging from condensed matter and atomic physics, to astrophysics and biophysics. The program also includes a number of professional development activities, “research horizons” faculty seminars, and a research symposium.

Participants will receive a stipend of \$5,000 for the ten-week program, a travel allowance, and housing on the Georgia Tech campus. Participants must be U.S citizens or permanent residents of the U.S.
